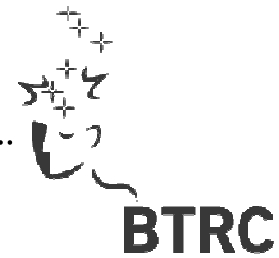


# BRAIN TUMOUR RESEARCH CAMPAIGN

Brain Tumour Research, the umbrella charity for 14 brain tumour charities throughout the UK, welcomed the C4 programme screened last night, about the life of Mo Mowlam, who died in 2005 from a brain tumour. Brain tumours kill more children and young people than any other cancer. Channel 4's programme 'Mo' made accessible what some would see as a difficult subject.

Mo Mowlam's own doctor, **Dr Mark Glaser**, Chief of Service, Cancer Services and lead clinician Neuro-Oncology at Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust and also **trustee of Brain Tumour Research Campaign**, one of the charities that is part of Brain Tumour Research, said today, "I hope that the Channel 4 programme about Mo Mowlam might help the general public understand this difficult and as yet not fully understood disease."
